# Return to Huronia Dedication Memorial Huronia

On August 24, 2019 Joe Lambert, his wife and his facilitator drove to Orillia for the dedication ceremony "Honouring Lives lived and Lost at Huronia Regional Centre". Joe, our valued board member used to live at Huronia as a young boy. It left him scarred and traumatized for life. This was the first time going back for him since he left the institution about 40 years ago.

As Joe entered the grounds many memories came back to him. At first you see a lovely place, quiet, near the lake, with beautiful buildings. That is if you don't know the history of this place

The Huronia Regional Centre housed children and adults for more than 130 years. It was known as an institution for people with developmental delays. The centre's doors finally shut in 2009. Many children and adults died and we all heard the horrific stories about the abuse that happened between these walls Survivors advocated long and hard for this monument.

The monument that was reveiled is about 12-feet tall and features two pillars representing the institutional walls that trapped those inside.

Breaking through the pillars is a tree, with crows flying off the branches. Forget-me-nots and a butterfly symbolize remembrance and growth. Words on the walls reveal testaments from the survivors:

"You have no idea." "Forced labour with no pay." "Babies died here."

These people are survivors. They didn't have a voice for many, many years but now they do. This monument is to honour those that lost their lives and to celebrate the survivors. For Joe this visit gave him some closure. He will continue to advocate to make sure people won't forget what has happened and that this will never happen again!

As of April 2019 the funding for the Demonstration Project ended which left Facile without any core fundina.

We continue to offer Independent Facilitation and Planning in a Fee- for Service Model.

People can use part of their Passport Funding to purchase Facilitation or they can pay out of pocket.

We have skilled facilitators in Perth, Oxford and Huron County.

#### Workshop:" Let's talk about sex, relationships and how to stay safe
