As of April 2019 the funding for the Demonstration Project ended which left Facile without any core funding.

We continue to offer Independent Facilitation and Planning in a Fee- for Service Model.

People can use part of their Passport Funding to purchase Facilitation or they can pay out of pocket.

We have skilled facilitators in Perth, Oxford and Huron County.

We are happy to say that Diane will continue to provide facilitation to families in Oxford County.
